The Pennsylvania Master Naturalist program will take place at the **Silver Lake Nature Center** in **Bucks County** in Fall of 2018. The program is a great opportunity for educators, volunteers, and nature-lovers alike to receive natural science training and be part of a prestigious group of citizen volunteers working to earn their PA Master Naturalist certification.

During the first year of becoming certified, you will collect an understanding of natural sciences in the context of Pennsylvania's ecological systems (initial training course), deepen strong, foundational knowledge through continuing education, then extend your knowledge to the community through volunteer service in natural resource education and conservation.

Pennsylvania Master Naturalist is a statewide partnership initiative that aims to connect people with their local ecosystems through intensive natural science training and local conservation service work. It is a venture directed toward developing a local corps of "master volunteers and service providers" to offer education, outreach and service dedicated to the understanding and management of natural areas within their communities.
